It is important that when you receive Christ's love and forgiveness you tell someone about it just as soon as possible. Tell a pastor and one or two close friends; it will help seal this act of faith in your mind and heart.

CMU is planning for on-campus, in-person education for fall and winter terms 2020/21, with hybrid extensions through online tools for all classes. Clear protocols and training to ensure the health and safety of students, staff and faculty will be in place. We are also working extensively at community and individual well-being as we face the intense burdens and anxieties of this pandemic time.
